Call Committee Update

"Commit your work to the Lord, and your plans will be established". Proverbs 16:3

The Call Committee would like to update all of you on the work that has been done in regards to calling a second pastor to Faith. We have been working diligently to find a person that fits the Congregational survey requests, the requests made by Pastor Woolsey and whose personal and professional goals fit within the ministries at Faith. On July 13, 2023 Faith Lutheran Church received an initial candidate list from the District office for review. The list contained the names of 11 individuals. Five were nominated from members of Faith Lutheran Church (*) and the remaining 6 suggested by the District, based on the results of the congregational self-study information submitted by Faith.

Of those 11 candidates:

- -3 of the candidates were not available to consider a Call at this time for various reasons.
- -2 asked to be removed from consideration upon first contact from the Call Committee due to stated reasons.
- -2 indicated that they would not be inclined to pursue a call at this time for specific personal reasons.
- -1 never responded to initiated contact from the Call committee.
- -3 were open to discussion in regards to the Call process.

Of the 3 remaining candidates:

- -After review of sermon videos and self-evaluation information, the Call committee decided unanimously to not pursue discussion with 1 candidate.
- -Interviews were scheduled with the remaining 2 candidates (8/15/23, 8/16/23)
 - *At the conclusion of the first interview, it was determined that the Call committee would not pursue further conversations with 1 candidate.
 - *A 2nd interview was scheduled with the remaining candidate (8/22/23) at the conclusion of this conversation, the candidate indicated a reservation about considering a Call at this time. No contact from the candidate after 8/22/23.

At this time the Call Committee views the candidate list, dated 7/13/23, as having been exhausted. We will be contacting the District office for a list of additional candidates. Below you will find the list of candidates and comments for each.


