# Baptism and Easter

I am always amazed by the work of the Holy Spirit as the Spirit continues to help me grow. How often have I had an "Aha" moment when something I have read or heard many times strikes a new and resonant chord that challenges my thinking or my memory so I seek to learn more? Such is a recent experience.

I don't think I'm alone here. I am pretty sure you, too, have heard the words of Paul in Romans 6:4 often and like me, you may have become immune to really listening or realize what you just heard. Let me explain.


In the last 14 months I have paid my respects and offered comforting words to the families of 15 friends and associates who have passed away. At my age it is to be expected as my peers and close associates are aging. In every service we spoke the words of Romans 6:4 connecting the deceased's baptism with the death of Christ: "We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life." Finally, I was able to really hear the strength of the expression "baptized into Christ," "baptized into His death" and "buried with Him in baptism." I see the connection between the celebration of Easter and our own baptisms.

Baptism signifies our union to Christ in His death and resurrection. Because of that union, we are granted a newness of life. Our baptism also comes with a commitment not only to walk in the newness of life but to tell everyone about what Jesus has done for us. To not only talk about forgiveness but to demonstrate forgiveness. To talk about our faith and the powerful work of God. It is our personal identification with the greatest act in human history. The death, burial and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

As we celebrate Easter, the gift from God of His beloved Son, Jesus Christ who gave of himself for our sins, so that death could be defeated, provide us salvation and a life of eternity with God. I hope you will also take the time to reflect and celebrate Baptism as well for you are confessing your faith because you are also saying "I died with Jesus Christ, I was buried with Him and now I am raised with Christ to a new life."
